Tryweryn Training - 23/24 July

There should be a release on the weekend of 23/24 July on the Tryweryn. Access is available over the whole length of the river from the Graveyard down to Bala as part of a "Charity Tour" - contact Canolfan Tryweryn over access details or to check on water. Some WWR paddlers are already planning to take advantage of this.

Some facts about access on the Tryweryn

The exclusive access times over the race weekends are granted to Wild Water Racing by the WCA as part of their policy of managing Canolfan Tryweryn. Stated bluntly (and your Exec are not happy with this) they make more money out of rafting and touring use, than WWR use.

If you are not entirely happy with this situation, then write to the WWR Chairman or Secretary giving some positive suggestions. The "tour ticket" requirement when sharing with a tour is an oversight and is unlikely to feature next year.

The layby and roadbridge access points are forbidden to all paddlers by the local police, concerned about road accidents.

The need to pay for access at the campsite bridge is caused by the termination of Canolfan Tryweryn's lease of this land, and the owners excessive demands for arranging a new lease. The problem currently affects all users of the Tryweryn.

WW Race down the World Cup course as part of the World Cup build up.

Open to any Div A WWR, Div 1/P slalom, Div 1/2 Marathon, Senior B sprint paddlers or equivalent.
