

2019 Canoe Slalom Reunion

Arrangements for the Slalom Reunion 2019 are progressing well and we look forward to a great time ahead! For those who are paddling; we trust your preparations are going to plan. Please be aware that there will be a dual scoring system (standard and handicapped) in operation, to encourage the use of the canoes of yesteryear.

The purpose of this email is to advise how payment for the reunion event can be made; the cut-off date is **15th May 2019**. Prompt payment from yourselves is vital to validate the booking with Lee Valley White Water Centre.

The 'entry fee' (for a firm reservation), is **£30 per person** and payment must be made via the British Canoe Slalom Committee on-line entry system. Once you have logged on to the system you will be able to view the Canoe Slalom Entries list – see 15th June 2019 Slalom Reunion.

Be patient as the system has been designed for slalom entries and has been adapted to cover SR2019 guests.

(1) If you are a new on-line entries user:

- Create a log in and validate your email
- Attached is a pdf crib sheet with a detailed explanation
- Having reached the checkout and paid,
- ... now purchase your event ticket(s) for the day from [British Canoeing](#)

OR

(2) If you are a user of the system already:

- Go in to on-line entries, seek 'Special' events or locate SR2019 on the calendar
- Click in to SR2019 and make your 'entry' and payment under your usual sign-in
- If you wish to add one or more persons (who are not users) then log out
..... proceed to **(1)** above on a different email address
- ... now purchase your event ticket(s) for the day from [British Canoeing](#)

The £30 entry fee covers: the SR2019 reception with buffet, access to the Legacy Channel, plus spectating and car-parking space inside the venue (close to the Legacy Channel). SR2019 has been allocated recreational space on the 'decking' where the buffet will be served from 18:30.

The buffet includes: Chef's choice of 3 salads, a selection of cold meats, poached salmon with lemon and dill, roast vegetable tartlets, butternut squash & quinoa bites, new potatoes, warm rolls and butter. Desserts include a fruit platter and a sweet treat to finish. **If you have any specialist dietary requirements, please advise asap.**

If you have entered the **Reunion Competition** your name will be listed on the [Canoeing Results](#) website. There is no extra charge for paddling on the Legacy Channel, but please be aware that training runs start 09:00 prompt.

The World Cup Competition Entry Ticket(s) you require can only be purchased through [British Canoeing](#). NB These tickets facilitate your entry into the venue as either a paddler or a spectator.

Wet weather arrangements: The buffet will be served inside. However, depending upon final reservation numbers we may need to provide a gazebo area on the decking. If you own a 3m x 3m gazebo, that you would be willing to lend us, we would appreciate hearing from you.
