

SELECTION OF BRITISH SLALOM TEAMS POLICY FOR 1983

1, Senior Team:

Selection Events:

- Grandtully (2nd - 3rd April 1983)
- Tryweryn (23th – 24th April 1983)

Eligible paddlers:

All members of the first and premier divisions, plus those invited by the Selection Committee.

Selection Policy:

(a) WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP –

a. Merano - Italy 11th -19th June 1983

Up to four boats will be selected in each class - first at each of the two selection events, the next on aggregate on points at the two events and one other at the absolute discretion of the Selection Committee. In the event of the same person winning both Selection Events then the second on aggregate will also be selected.

The team selected for the World Championship will participate in training camps in Britain; attend a ten-day training camp and competitions at Liptovský Mikuláš (12th - 24th May 1983) & a final meeting during the 4th – 5th June 1983 Tryweryn event.

(b) BOURG ST. MAURICE –

a. France· 28th – 29th May 1983

An Intermediate team consisting of paddlers of future International potential who have not been selected for the World Championship Team will receive limited support to attend this event. Selection will depend on results at the selection events and will be at the discretion of the Selection Committee.

(c) AUGSBURG (23rd - 24th July 1983)

Lofer (30th – 31st July 1983)

- a. A team will be selected after the World Championships for these experimental events. The composition of the team will depend on International results and on-going commitment. Available finance will also be taken into account.

(d) FOSTERS DRAUGHT INTERNATIONAL SLALOM

- a. Teams from England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales will represent Great Britain at this event. The English team will be selected on the results of the Serpent's Tail, International results and ranking positions. National Associations will announce their policies in due course.

2, Youth Teams:

Selection Events

Eligible paddlers:

- Grandtully (2nd – 3rd April 1983)
- Tryweryn (23rd - 24th April 1983)
- Washburn (7th – 8th May 1983)

All members of the first and premier divisions, plus those invited by the Selection Committee, who are Youth and Junior paddlers in 1983.

Selection Policy:

a EUROPEAN YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS - Spittal

- Six K1 Men, 3 K1 ladies and C1s as appropriate will be selected. A C2 may be selected. Selection will be based on the best two of the three results obtained at selection events.
- b YOUTH TEAM TRAINING TOUR - Seo d'Urgell
 - A team of Youth and Junior paddlers will be selected for the is event. The team will contain at least nine K1M Youth and Junior paddlers. Paddlers who attended the 1982 Youth Training tour to Mezzana as Youths are not eligible for selection. Selection will be based on the best two results obtained in selection events.

SENIOR and YOUTH TEAMS - PLEASE NOTE

In all cases selection of full teams will be dependent on those eligible being of sufficient standard, in the opinion of the Selection Committee, for the international events concerned.
