Slalom Committee decision that their ranking lists be compiled in future for the year January 1st to December 31st but that inaugurally events after November 1969 be deemed part of the 1970, the Manchester Canoe Club Trophy for the series of Dee races will not be awarded after Dee III but after the race to be held on November 15th 1970. (The increased entry fees agreed by the B.C.U. Slalom Committee will not apply until this latter race).

SAFETY NOTE. Any competitor not finishing the course must report as soon as possible to the officials at finish or take steps to ensure that his whereabouts is reported to the finish judge. Otherwise search parties and the police may be put to unnecessary trouble.
