Campsite; Appletreewick is situated near Burnsall in Wharfedale,
Yorkshire. Slalom signs will show the way from the A 65
Ilkley-Skipton road, to the site. Camping will be in
Mr. Falsshaw's field, and water will be available. It is
most important that the movement of cars is kept to a
minimum, otherwise the field will be lost. No litter,
please. A charge of 2/6d. per person per night, and 2/-
per vehicle per weekend will be payable on arrival.
Mr. Croft's mobile canteen will be on the site over the
weekend.

Regulations; The usual regulations regarding practice and safety will
apply. All boats must be rendered unsinkable and have loops
at bow and stern. Crash-hats will be worn at all times when
on the water, likewise lifejackets. PADDLING ABOVE OR BELOW
THE SITE IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.- A Practice course of about
six gates will be available. Please do not hog any part
of the competition or practice courses during practice.
