The following is the points scoring system that was use for determining the Southern Region Club Champions. The system was idendical to that used at last years event.

It should be noted that the points scoring system to be used for the National Inter Club Championships at Holme Pierrepont, may differ from this used in our own selection.

The winning club shall be that with the HIGHEST number of points.

The maximum points shall be ONE MORE than the number of clubs competing.

The points score for K1 M Premier and C 1 , shall be DOUBLE that of the other classes due to the requirement to have double the number of competitors.

A club without an entrant in a class will score NO points.

A competitor who starts but fails to finish WILL score points.

The final entry list comprised five club teams, the nominated entrants being specified to the organiser prior to the event commencing.

Mr. Jim Croft (organiser for the National event), has been informed of the Southern Region selection nominations of,

Windsor, Banbury and Newbury (as reserves)
it is now the responsibility of each club to ensure their entry is received by Jim on time and in accord with his entry procedures.

Please note, Jim is under pressure as Technical Director for the EUROPA CUP and club team managers should make special efforts to ensure their entries are recieved.

Very best wishes to both clubs (if not all 3) for the Holme Pierrpont National on 10/11 September.
