# Executive Report

## What is Executive Report?

Executive Report has been produced to try and encourage paddler participation in the running of our sport. The information that follows is from the executive meeting held at the Kegworth Hotel on the 4th of March. This is a paddler's eye view with the 'boring' day to day business left out, and the controversial issues very definitely included. This report will be distributed to clubs and event organisers - it may be freely copied and displayed.

## Holme Pierrepont Water Quality

The managers of the National Watersports Centre at Holme Pierrepont have stated that no cases of illness have been reported to them since November 1994. They are continuing to monitor the water quality and advise paddlers to ring before travelling as they will close the course during any period when they consider the bacteria levels to be unacceptably high. They have requested that any paddlers who become ill as a result of paddling at HPP contact them so that they can maintain an accurate picture of the problem.

## Ranking Status

A motion was passed at the AGM stating that for each club running events this season either the event organiser, or a club representative had to attend an organisers' conference this year or the club's events would be de-ranked. Three clubs did not attend. A lengthy debate took place involving issues of access, paddler inconvenience and the possible long term loss of events on the sites in question. After several less stringent options had been rejected it was finally decided that, for this year only, the clubs in question would be offered the chance to retain ranking status if they accepted the following conditions:

- They must find a experienced organiser who did attend the organisers' conference and is prepared to become involved in the organisation prior to the event and be present on the day.
- A full executive jury will be appointed and the organising club will be responsible for payment of full expenses for the jury.

## Tryweryn Premier

Due to an oversight, the water release at Tryweryn was booked for 12th March, while the premier event was booked for 11th March. Water is being purchased for the Saturday, but is limited to an eight hour release. The organiser has been consulted, and the program adjusted accordingly. Competitions Committee will review the circumstances to prevent this situation recurring.

## World Championships

Several Sponsors have now been confirmed but more are still required. Any possible leads should be relayed direct to Brian Wharton. Promotional material is now being distributed and identification of personnel has begun.

## Teeside International

Due to water restrictions imposed by the tides there will be space for a maximum of 120 competitors at this event. The division 4/5 at the beginning of April will be used to test the site equipment prior to the International. Technical and Timing reported that in order to guarantee 100% availability of electronic timing at the International they could not service the Washburn Division 1 on the same weekend. It was agreed that the Teeside International should be timed to the same standard as the World Cup race was (that used for Premier races), with the second set of timing equipment being used for the Washburn event.

## Pool Slalom

The 1996 Canoe Exhibition will be held at the NEC where there is no pool! A working party will consider alternative venues - ideas to Ken Trollope!

## Washburn

Steve Ackroyd reported that funds have been found to complete the construction of the toilet block at Washburn. In addition, further developments are planned including extending the road so that lower stretches of the river can be used for competition.

## Event Sponsorship

Sponsors' bibs were defaced at the Pool Slalom and Hon Sec is to consider appropriate disciplinary action. It was agreed that in future paddlers would be made aware of any sponsorship agreements prior to an event, but that in all cases, event sponsorship agreements must be upheld by all paddlers choosing to compete.

## Jury Chairman

A volunteer is urgently required to co-ordinate the appointment of Jury Chairman for Division 2-5 races.
