2023 Race – Directors' Comments

Whilst every DW race is unique with its combination of weather and flow conditions, 2023 was exceptional. A dry February led into a very wet March with something like 150% of the average rainfall. In particular, a dump of rain over southern England about 10 days before the race saw close to flooding levels and full Red Boards on the Thames. In order to run a race, additional screening of competitors was introduced so that suitably competent and experienced crews could attempt to reach Westminster. This reduced the Senior Doubles field by around half. These results, therefore, do not include crews that may have been able to successfully complete the race on the fast-flowing Thames. Nevertheless, the Directors have decided to award trophies across all classes and sub-classes with eligible finishers.

The Thames conditions also necessitated a decision to finish the Stages race at Dreadnought Reach. This decision was reached in consultation with the School's Team Leaders and the Environment Agency. The Directors decided this shortened race would be a race with the awarding of medals, certificates and trophies.

The Endeavour class would have run to Westminster had there been sufficient crews to allow an option of grouping boats of similar speed down the course to improve safety. The minimum number of entrants to realistically enable this was not reached, which also meant that the Directors did not have reasonable grounds to justify the deployment of the dozens of volunteers and safety personnel for this element of the race and this class also finished at Dreadnought Reach.

The high flow conditions led to much excitement over the possibility of breaking some of the course records. The previous course record set in 1979 by Brian Greenham and Tim Cornish of 15:34:12 has been broken. Brian and Tim remain legends in the annals of DW history. And the Directors are delighted to announce that Brian and Tim will be presenting the DW 2023 prizes.

DW has two trophies that seek nominations from the DW community, The Sir Louis and Lady Gluckstein Trophy, awarded to the crew or individual displaying exceptional courage and fortitude, and the Jon White Trophy, for the disabled paddler, or paddlers, displaying exceptional determination and resolve over adversity. This year a number of very worthy nominations have been received and the Directors genuinely struggled to decide between very different but equally meritorious cases before arriving at their final choices.

For the 2023 race, The Directors have awarded the John White Trophy to Dougal Glaisher from Exeter CC (boat 348). Dougal has Type 1 Diabetes and over and above the normal race preparation that every competitor has to undertake, he had to carefully manage his

sugar and insulin levels both for the days before the race as well as during the whole event to avoid a hypoglycaemic episode. Add into the mix that he was aiming for a podium finish in his first Senior Doubles race when a completion would have been a justifiable target, he is a worthy recipient of the award.

The Directors decided that The Sir Louis and Lady Gluckstein Trophy should be awarded to Dave Branchflower from Wey KC (boat 361). Dave has been an ostomate for some three years, and the 2023 DW was his first test of how such an endurance race would challenge the change to his body. The race was certainly not easy going for him, but his courage and fortitude pulled him through some tough times that would have defeated many, and he now has another successful DW finish with his ever supportive paddling partner, Shane Houghting.

The final, non-racing based trophy open to paddlers is the Pfeiffer Cup. Awarded to the paddler, or crew, that raises the most money for Charity, this trophy enables competitors to help others through their efforts. The 2023 winners are Kat Burbeck and Daniel Palmer from Reading CC and Fowey River CC (boat 345) who raised £6,467 for Sarcoma UK. They also formed part of a 3 boat team of fundraisers whose combined total reached over $\pounds 11,000$ for the charity. The Sarcoma UK charity has a special meaning to the DW and wider paddling community as James Smythe, a much missed member of both, lost his battle against the disease in 2022. It is worthy of note that across all the paddlers in the 2023 race, the total money raised for charities was over £45,000 – a magnificent effort by all.

The Directors also have the discretion to award The Peter Begent Trophy to the person or organisation who has made an outstanding contribution to the running of the race. For 2023 this award has been given to Sally Peake – known to all the paddlers as the official Starter (although her role involves a wider remit on the timekeeping side of the race). Sally has been involved with DW for 50 years, serving as a supporter, school coach, committee member and a stalwart of the timekeeping team since 2004. She is a major part of the DW family and we want to acknowledge her involvement and support with this award. Sally is not retiring from her involvement with the race and has already told us she will be back with the starter's claxon in 2024!

We and the Team look forward to welcoming you to what will be a very special 2023 Prize Giving ceremony.
