

LYNHER / TAMAR LONG DISTANCE CANOE  
RACE

SUNDAY 16th April 1967

COURSE: 14 Miles

THE RACE: Has been made a Ranking Race by the National Long Distance Racing Committee.

THE COURSE: Will start and finish down river from the Ferry at Torpoint. Competitors will paddle up the River Tamar to the confluence of the River Lynher on the left. They will turn left at this junction and proceed up the River Lynher to the railway viaduct crossing the river at St. Germans, turn anti-clockwise under the middle arch and return to the starting point. See attached map.

CLASSES: As for B.C.U., Long Distance Racing Rules. All classes - Senior and Junior Sections and Ladies.

Class 1. K.1's

Class 2. K.2's

Class 3. Singles (Max. L.O.A. 15ft. Min Beam 23ins.

Class 4. Doubles (Max. L.O.A. 18ft. Min Beam 24ins.

In addition, entries will be accepted for Rigid and Folding Doubles. (Seniors only).

PRIZES: Will be awarded to winners in all Classes. (Classes with less than three entries will be cancelled).

Prize awards in classes, minimum entry 5. 1st & 2nd.  
Prize awards in classes, minimum entry 3. 1st only.

START: Will be at Torpoint (site of new Rowing Club Headquarters) near to the Ferry. Race commences at 0930hrs. (Starting time governed by the tide).

Competitors are requested to be at the Starting Line at 0900hrs. Massed Start.

SAFETY: All craft must have adequate buoyancy. Life Jackets must be carried by all crews and worn at the discretion of the organisers. Junior crews must wear Life Jackets throughout the Race.

ENTRY FESS: An entry fee of 5/- per competitor is made and should be enclosed with entry form.

A list of competitors will be sent to all entries received.

Entries close FIRST POST Saturday 8th April 1967.

Entries will be accepted up to one hour before the race commences at DOUBLE FEES

FOOD: Light refreshments will be available to the competitors free of charge at the end of the race and, on sale to spectators.

OVERNIGHT: Accommodation will be made available at Torpoint. Sleeping rough. In local hall. Please indicate if you will need this facility.


