You will note that two times are missing, a lot of confusion was caused by paddlers writing over former numbers, and to the greatest part of people joining in the race although not having entered and paid a fee, and refusing to take off previous race numbers. We think this very unsporting.

ENTRY FEES: SENIORS: 8/6d per paddler.

JUNIORS &
LADIES: 7/6d per paddler.

No Entry will be accepted unless correct fee accompanies the entry.

SAFETY: Buoyancy, Life-jackets and spray cover must be carried, as per B.C.U. rules.

GENERAL: Competitors should keep well away from moored craft and steer clear of steamers and pleasure craft. Above Teddington keep to towpath side of the river.

Competitors must not obstruct any canoe which is overtaking and must not come into contact with other canoes or paddles. The only method of propulsion is by double bladed paddles. Competitors must not "wash hang" and any competitor taking pace or riding the wake of a powered craft on the river will be disqualified.

All B.C.U. Rules will be strictly adhered to and competitors should be sure that they are familiar with these Rules. The Judges' decision is final on all matters.

PROTESTS must be lodged immediately after the Race and then confirmed in writing to the Secretary WITHIN SEVEN DAYS.
